

Combined Hackney Carriage Private Hire Drivers Licence Applicants

Practical Driving Assessment

Newark and Sherwood District Council require all those applying for a Combined Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Drivers Licence to pass a practical driving assessment. We currently have 1 provider and we are working to increase the number of providers in order to provide choice and flexibility for our drivers.

You will need a suitable vehicle for test purposes which has current and valid insurance, MOT, has road tax and is fit for use on a public road. You will be required to complete an eye test by reading a standard number plate from a distance of 20 metres in daylight. If you require the use of glasses or contact lenses to do this you will be required to wear them during your assessment.

The driving assessment will consist of approximately a 40 minute drive designed to evaluate your driving standards. Your assessor will also ask you to perform two reversing manoeuvres and possibly an emergency stop. You will also be asked to drive for a period independently either following road signs or using a satellite navigation system Your assessor will allow you to 9 driver faults often referred to as “minors”, but zero serious or dangerous faults often referred to as “major faults”.
